For 2010-2011, Volinia Outcomes School did not make Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) because, 1) We did not test 95% of our students, 2) We did not attain target achievement goals in English language arts and 3) We did not attain target achievement goals in mathematics. If we do not make AYP for two years in a row, we will be identified for school improvement.
